Dear Senator Schumer,

It has become public that a member of your staff was fired for inappropriate behavior with his subordinates. By media accounts, the behavior was sexual in nature. We applaud you for terminating this staff member's employment. We agree with you that such alleged behavior is totally unacceptable on any level of government or anywhere else in the public sphere.

In light of these recent revelations, will you please tell me if you or your staff have used taxpayer money to settle any claim against any of your staff for inappropriate behavior? If you could specifically tell me if any settlements came from your campaign funds, that would be greatly appreciated. I am sure you will agree that the American people for whom you work have a right to know.

In addition, could you please clarify if any funds used to settle claims against your staff came from the fund administered by the Office of Compliance (OOC,) which is used for the payment of awards and settlements? The OOC is overseen by the House Administration and Senate Rules committees, so you should have that information readily available.
